ORDINANCE SUMMARY



Pickens County Ordinance # 297, SECTION # 6, makes it illegal to have a "JUNKED or ABANDONED VEHICLE" in a RESIDENTIAL area. The Pickens County Code Enforcement Officer enforces all ordinances, and if found in violation of Ordinance #297, homeowners could be fined up to \$500.00. To avoid prosecution for this violation, the following remedies are provided for in the Ordinance:

- 1. Each vehicle is to be covered with a factory car cover (Tarps are not allowed).
- 2. Store vehicles in a totally enclosed building.
- 3. Remove vehicle from premises.
- 4. All junk is to be out of view of all public roads and adjacent properties.
